La seconda domenica di Pasqua è la cosiddetta "Domenica della Divina Misericordia". È chiamata così in seguito alle richieste che Gesù rivolse a santa Faustina, di celebrare la domenica successiva a quella di Pasqua in onore dell'infinita misericordia con cui Egli ci ha amati e redenti. Il Vangelo di oggi si armonizza molto bene con il tema della Misericordia. Il brano dell'evangelista Giovanni riporta infatti l'apparizione di Gesù agli Apostoli. In quella apparizione Gesù istituì il sacramento della Riconciliazione: «Ricevete lo Spirito Santo. A coloro a cui perdonerete i peccati, saranno perdonati; a coloro a cui non perdonerete, non saranno perdonati». Con queste parole, Gesù ha dato alla Chiesa il potere di rimettere i peccati.

A Santa Faustina, Gesù fece una meravigliosa promessa. Egli volle che in questa domenica si parlasse della Divina Misericordia e disse: «Chi si accosterà alla sorgente della vita – ovvero alla Confessione e alla Comunione – questi conseguirà la remissione totale delle colpe e delle pene». Poi continuò dicendo: «L'umanità non troverà pace, finché non si rivolgerà con fiducia alla Mia Misericordia. In questa domenica siamo chiamati anche noi a glorificare l'infinita Misericordia di Dio. Accostiamoci con fiducia al Sacramento del suo perdono, fondando il nostro proposito di non peccare più non sulle nostre forze, che sono molto piccole, ma sul suo santo aiuto, come recitiamo nell'"Atto di dolore".

Mercy and belief are two concepts to be prayerfully opened or explored in today's Gospel according to John on the Second Sunday of Easter. But the merciful Jesus goes to the disciples and twice tells them, "Peace be with you." He gives them the gift of the Holy Spirit. He sends them out in the same way his Father sent him. When Jesus appears to Thomas and the disciples a week later, He tells them to be at peace and invites Thomas to believe. Thomas answers Jesus with the purest response to communicate belief, love and humility: "My Lord and my God!" Being merciful and loving to others and believing in the mercy and love of God can be a daily challenge.

Devotion to Jesus, the Divine Mercy

"As I have loved you so also should you love one another." (John 13:34)

The Image of the pierced side of Christ pouring out blood and water reminds us that the Cross, love in action, is the price of mercy.

The message is as simple as ABC:

A — Ask for His Mercy. God wants us to approach Him in prayer constantly, repenting of our sins and asking Him to pour His mercy out upon us and upon the whole world. **"Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us"** (Matt 6:12)

B — Be merciful. God wants us to receive His mercy and let it flow through us to others. He wants us to extend love and forgiveness to others as He does to us. **"The measure with which you measure will be measured out to you"** (Matt 7:2)

C — Completely trust in Jesus. God wants us to know that the graces of His mercy are dependent upon our trust. The more we trust in Jesus, the more we will receive. **"Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy"** (Matt 5:7)
