Welcome, new parishioners!

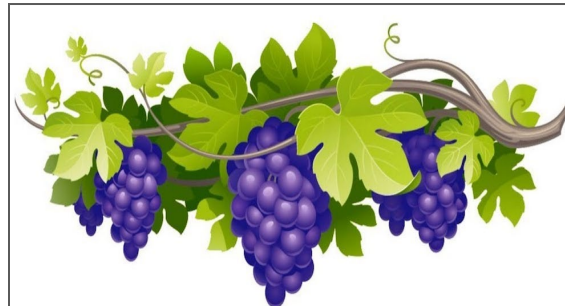
We invite new parishioners to register with the parish. Registration forms and donation envelopes are available in the entrance of the church and at the parish office.

Christ write no books. He left no buildings or monuments behind. Yet he did something far greater and more necessary, he built a community. That was his “monument.”

In today’s gospel, He said to his apostles, “I am the vine, you are the branches.” He used this image in talking about the community he had founded. It is a simple but profound illustration of unity, closeness and interdependence.

Just as the branches needs the vine, so we need Christ. Separated from him, we have no life and are unable to bear fruit. But the vine also needs the branches – it is the branches that produce the fruit.

Which means that Christ also needs us. We are his branches. Vine and branches need each other. Together they form a unity. Christ depends on us to produce fruit in the world.
