April 6, 2023 – 5th Sunday of Lent

“Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?” She said, “No one Lord. “And Jesus said, “Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on sin no more.” What Jesus says here is incredibly important—Jesus pardons the woman, but He doesn’t say that her sin doesn’t matter or that it isn’t a big deal. Instead, he specifically addresses the sin—by telling her to “sin no more,” He indicates that He knew that she was indeed guilty of adultery and that she needed to change and start new life in the Lord. This leads to an important idea that is central to the Gospel—*Jesus offers us pardon*, not acquittal. He doesn’t come to us and say, “Your sin is not a big deal; no crime has been committed, you are innocent.” Instead, He says, “Your sin is significant; it must be paid for through good life and repentance.

Like this woman, Jesus is always giving us new opportunities despite our weaknesses. He knows how vulnerable we are to sin. He knows the forces we contend with in our life and society. His mission is to save us from all our sins and accusations. It is not to condemn us.

“Donna, dove sono? Nessuno ti ha condannata? “Lei disse:” Nessuno Signore “. E Gesù disse:” Neanch’io ti condanno; vai, e d’ora in poi non peccare più “. Quello che Gesù dice qui è incredibilmente importante: Gesù perdona la donna, ma Lui non dice che il suo peccato non ha importanza o che non è un grosso problema. Invece, si rivolge specificamente al peccato - dicendole di “non peccare più”, Egli indica che Egli sapeva che lei era davvero colpevole di adulterio e che aveva bisogno di cambiare e iniziare una nuova vita nel Signore. Ciò conduce a un’idea importante che è centrale per il Vangelo - Gesù ci offre il perdono, non l’assoluzione. Non viene da noi e dice: “Il tuo peccato non è un grosso problema; nessun crimine è stato commesso, tu sei innocente. “Invece, Egli dice:” Il tuo peccato è significativo; deve essere pagato attraverso la vita buona e il pentimento. Il nostro peccato è un affare così grande che Gesù ne ha pagato il prezzo sulla croce; a causa di questo sacrificio, il perdono può essere offerto alla donna adultera e ai peccatori come me e tutti noi.


