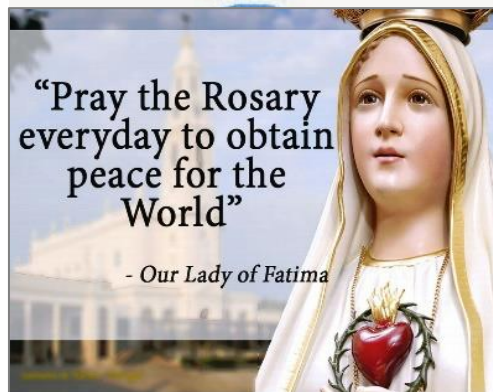



Today's gospel highlights the demands of discipleship, that is, the commitments disciples are called to make if they truly want to follow the Lord. Today, as in all times, choosing to follow Jesus and live as believers means making choices that go against the world, exposing oneself to the risk of judgment and misunderstanding, even from family and friends: it means taking a stand against those who choose themselves and not Him, the God of peace. This is the sense in which we should understand the "division" that Jesus says he came to bring.
