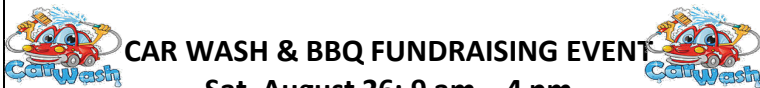

In today's gospel the Canaanite woman, who begs for the healing of her daughter, is the concrete sign performed by Jesus to say that in the eyes of God the value of a person does not depend on his belonging to a privileged group, but on the quality of his faith and by the tears that wet the faces marked by suffering. The request for even a few crumbs sought by the woman moves Jesus.

Even our love for others must be a love without borders, without privileges, without preferences, without reservations, because from us Christians the world expects crumbs of communion, sharing and fraternity.
