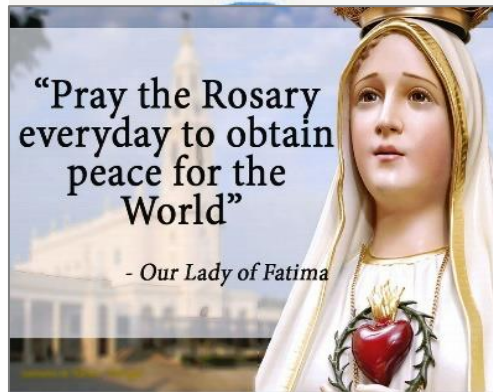

#### 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C

Today's gospel is telling us about our choice.

A door or gate always represents choice. As long as a room has a door we can enter and exit it. We can choose to go in and choose to leave, to enclose or expand ourselves. The narrow door is Jesus self-giving way of life. His way means turning the other cheek, going the extra mile, loving even our enemies.

In the gospel today, Jesus presses his followers to invest in the poor rather than in bigger granaries, to store up unfailing treasure with God. His way calls us to forgive other's debts and invest ourselves and our wealth in providing a leg up for those our economy leaves behind and who have no hope of repaying us. The narrow door is not an isolated saying but an image of Jesus' way.

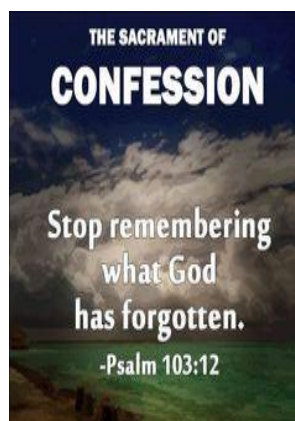
