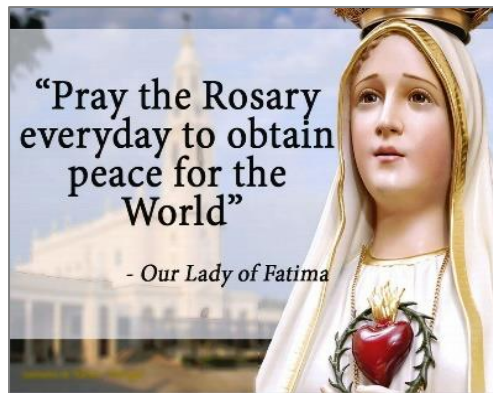

Children who attend public or Catholic school or are being Home
schooled, who are 8 years old (in grade3) or older and who have not been
baptized or received First Communion.

The 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time for 2025 is a reflection on the
parable of the rich fool, which serves as a reminder of the importance
of what truly matters in life. The readings and Gospel emphasize that
our lives are not measured by what we possess but by what we give.
Jesus teaches that the accumulation of wealth for oneself is futile and
that true richness comes from being rich in what matters to God,
such as love and service to others. This reflection encourages us to
focus on spiritual growth, generosity, and the well-being of those
around us, rather than accumulating material possessions.
