The Beatitudes are a rich treasure of God's revelation. Here is to be seen the focused image of the Christian life. Here in fact is the face of Christ himself. To be ignorant of the Scriptures, St Jerome said in the 4th century, is to be ignorant of Christ.

Not to read and study the Beatitudes is not to read and study the face of Christ.

Beatitudes is like a road map that Jesus gives us, to tell us how to get to our destination—*happiness and fulfillment here and now, and eternal life in the future*.

Each Beatitude calls us to be and do for others. Each one calls us to bear witness, by our lives, that we belong to Christ. We are his people, and we follow him in his example of life.


