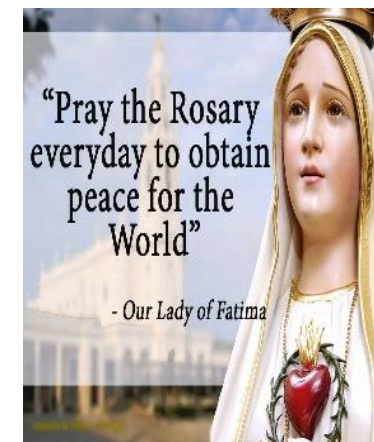

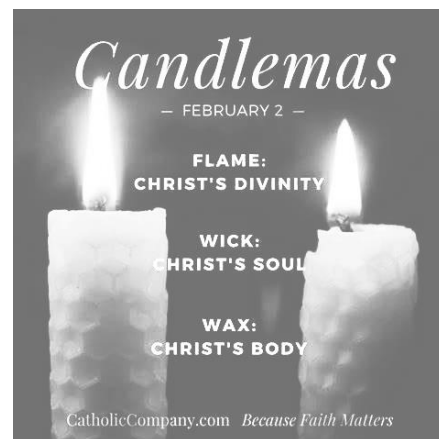

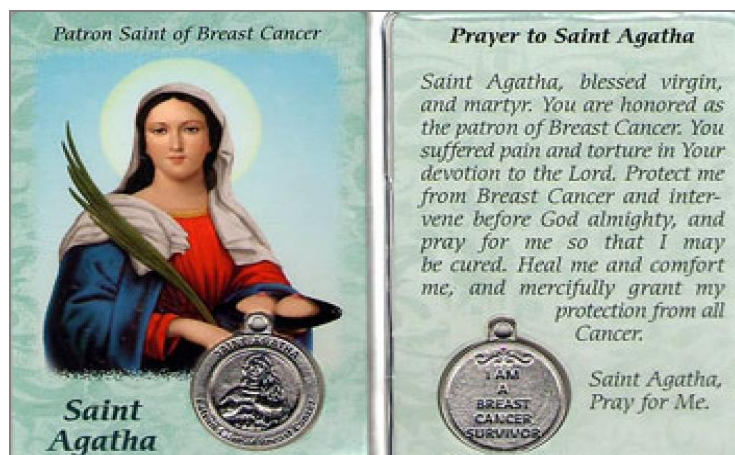

February 2, 2025 – Presentation of the Lord

Il Vangelo di oggi racconta la Presentazione del bambino Gesù al Tempio, una festa nota anche come *Festa della Purificazione di Maria* e *Festa della Candelora*. È anche chiamata *Festa dell'Incontro* dei Due Testamenti, con l'Antico Testamento rappresentato da Simeone e Anna e il Nuovo Testamento incarnato da Gesù, il nuovo Tempio di Dio.

La Scrittura evidenzia la totale obbedienza di Giuseppe e Maria, mentre seguivano le leggi delineate nell'Antico Testamento. Sebbene Maria, la più santa delle donne e sempre Vergine, non fosse vincolata dalla legge, si sottomise umilmente al rituale di purificazione, proprio come qualsiasi madre ebrea. Giuseppe e Maria presentarono Gesù al tempio per essere redento: Lui, il Redentore, che appartiene interamente a Dio. Seguendo la legge, dimostrarono la loro obbedienza a Dio, anche se non ne erano obbligati.

Questo esempio ci invita ad arrenderci completamente alla legge di Dio nelle nostre vite. Così come presentiamo noi stessi e le nostre famiglie a ogni Messa, offrendoli sull'altare davanti a Dio Padre per mezzo di Gesù Cristo, sforziamoci di vivere una vita santa, comprendendo che siamo consacrati a Dio e che Cristo è presente in noi e negli altri.



Today's Gospel recounts the Presentation of the baby Jesus in the Temple, a feast also known as the *Feast of the Purification of Mary* and the *Feast of Candlemas*. It's also referred to as the *Feast of the Encounter* of the Two Testaments, with the Old Testament represented by Simeon and Anna, and the New Testament embodied by Jesus, the new Temple of God.

The scripture highlights the total obedience of Joseph and Mary, as they followed the laws outlined in the Old Testament. Although Mary, the holiest of women and ever Virgin was exempted, she humbly submitted to the purification ritual, just as any Jewish mother. Joseph and Mary presented Jesus at the temple to be redeemed — He, the Redeemer, who belongs entirely to God. By following the law, they demonstrated their obedience to God, even though they were not bound by it.

This example invites us to fully surrender to God's law in our own lives. Just as we present ourselves and our families at every Mass, offering them on the altar before God the Father through Jesus Christ, let us strive to live holy lives, understanding that we are consecrated to God and that Christ is present in us and in others.
