

Quando viviamo in questo modo, la presenza di Cristo diventa visibile nel mondo attraverso di noi.

Gesù ci dice che una lampada non è fatta per essere nascosta sotto un cesto. È posta su un supporto in modo che possa illuminare tutti in casa. Ognuno di noi porta con sé una luce che deve essere vista, non per la propria lode, ma affinché gli altri possano intravedere la bontà di Dio all'opera. Una parola di incoraggiamento, la disponibilità a perdonare, l'impegno a servire o il coraggio di difendere ciò che è giusto possono diventare una piccola ma potente fiamma che cambia una vita. In today's Gospel, Christ asks us to be the salt of the earth and the light of the world.

Salt and light are simple elements, yet they are powerful. Salt preserves and enhances flavor but only when it is shared. Light dispels darkness but only when it shines outward. Neither exists for its own sake. In the same way, our faith comes alive when it is poured out for others through compassion, integrity, generosity, and quiet acts of service. When we live this way, the presence of Christ becomes visible in the world through us.

Jesus tells us that a lamp is not meant to be hidden under a basket. It is placed on a stand so that it can give light to all in the house. Each of us carries a light that is meant to be seen, not for our own praise, but so that others may glimpse the goodness of God at work. A word of encouragement, a willingness to forgive, a commitment to serve, or the courage to stand for what is right can become a small but powerful flame that changes a life. When we choose to be salt and light, we discover that God works through our willingness in ways we could never have imagined. Saint Francis of Assisi once said, "All the darkness in the world cannot extinguish the light of a single candle." That candle is already within you. Let it shine. – Fr. Louis Okot




Amen.





