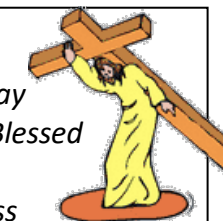

TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

The Gospel of today speaks of Jesus’ transfiguration on Mt. Tabor while praying. The transfiguration gives us a brief glimpse of the life to come in heaven. 


Handicraft Holy Land Christians
