Ma per essere davvero testimoni e annunciatori del Cristo occorre ancorare la propria vita nella preghiera e nella contemplazione: Gesù si ritira a pregare solo in un luogo deserto e indica la strada maestra che dobbiamo seguire se vogliamo essere suoi veri discepoli.

TODAY the Gospel presents us with an episode that reveals the great humanity of Jesus: Peter's mother-in-law lies sick in bed and the Lord, with a gesture as simple as it is affectionate, takes her by the hand, lifts her up and heals her from the fever (Gospel) . What might appear to be just a miracle, the fruit of the power of Christ, or a gesture of friendship, is actually the opportunity for the evangelist Mark to re-propose the purpose of miracles: to inspire faith and discipleship. Peter's mother-in-law, healed, places herself at the service of Jesus! The miracle is a moment in which a person, strongly perceiving the love of God, understands that life must be referred to Him; one has joy in listening to his Word, and is committed to bearing witness to the Gospel.

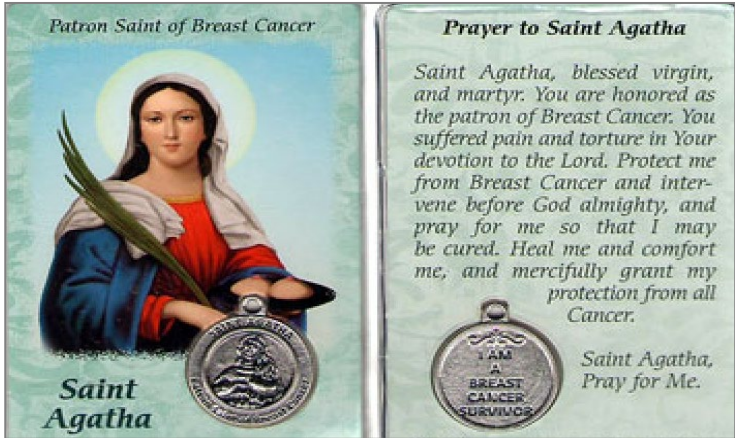
On the lighter side.....
