
#### Jan. 14, 2024 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's readings are all about listening and responding to the call of the Lord.

First, like Samuel, we are reminded of the importance of listening and paying attention to the voice of the Lord and treasuring his word. Second, like Eli and Andrew, we are enjoined to share the good news with others and lead them to the Lord, but then let the Lord take over. We must not stand in the way. Third, we are challenged to clarify what we are looking for in life and what we are hoping for from the Lord. Finally, if we want to be true disciples of Jesus, we must be prepared to spend time with him and develop a personal relationship with him. - Society of African Mission

Una fede che plasmi tuta la vita, anche il rapporto con il proprio corpo, come Paolo ci escorta oggi, rivelando il valore straordinario del corpo umano: "il corpo non e per l'impurita, ma per il Signore, e il Signore e per il corpo". Non dimentichiamo che il mistero dell'incarnazione che abbiamo appena celebrato ci e stato affidato perche illumini interamente la nostra umanita!



#### **Annual Week of Prayer for Christian Unity Prayer Service** 2024


January 18-25, 2024, marks the annual celebration of the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity (WPCU).
