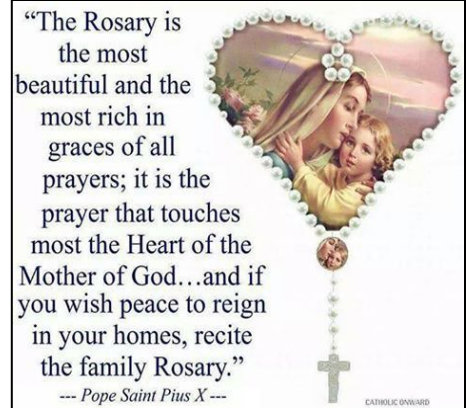

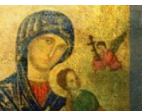

Jan. 21, 2024 – 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Today I am interested in my affections, my feelings, my purchases and my possessions. Tomorrow I will think of the Lord!" If we behave in this way, we are crazy, Paul told us in the second reading. The salvation that is offered to us, is now! The time is short! It is today! Not tomorrow. We must do like the pagans of Nineveh who, as soon as they heard Jonah's preaching, took the path of conversion. They didn't postpone it until the next day. Immediately "they believed God and proclaimed a fast, they put on sackcloth, both great and small". Truly, one must not be like Jonah who, although very religious, fled God's call, and then became indignant because God showed mercy to him. Yes, we must immediately respond to the call of Jesus who today proclaims: "the time is fulfilled and the kingdom of God is near: "repent" that is, "believe in the gospel". Let's not put it off until tomorrow, let's live this Word today! Let's look at Peter and his companions. They didn't reply "Let's finish the fishing first, let's go to dinner, and then we'll think about it...", instead "they immediately left their nets and followed him..." - La Domenica

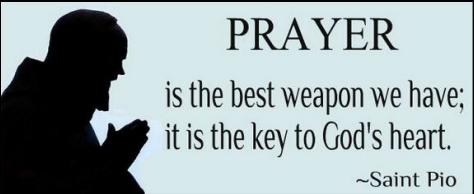
