January 15, 2023 – 2nd Sunday in O. T.

In questa domenica il Vangelo ci presenta la grande testimonianza di Giovanni Battista su Gesù: «Ecco l'Agnello di Dio che toglie il peccato del mondo». Gesù' e' il Servo che dovrà prendere su di sé i peccati di tutti, ricondurre i superstiti d'Israele nella vera terra promessa, portare la salvezza fino all'estremità della terra, annullare il fallimento dell'umanità e del mondo. Risuona nelle parole di Giovanni l'annuncio del tempo nuovo, il tempo in cui tutti sono chiamati alla salvezza.

L'immagine di Gesù, Agnello e Servo, ci richiama allo stile di vita di sacrificio per amore; un offerta generosa della nostra vita che ci immerge nella vita stessa di Dio. Ancora l'immagine di Gesù' come agnello ci invita a dare la nostra vita per Dio e per il bene e salvezza degli altri ovunque ci troviamo.

Today, we begin the ordinary time of the liturgical year and the readings tell us about the identity of Jesus and what his mission is. He is the Lamb of God: "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world". The word Lamb in the Jewish religious life has deep meaning. It is a symbol of purity and of innocence; it is also a sign of sacrifice for salvation.

Jesus is the Lamb of God, who died for our sins as the 1st reading says: ".... Like a lamb, led to the slaughter... He was wounded for our sins, bruised for our iniquities. He has taken upon himself the chastisement that makes us whole".

John recognizes that Jesus is not only who takes away the sins of the Jews and Christians but also all the sins of the world. The message is plain: If Jesus takes away the sins of the world, then, of course, he takes away our sin, whatever our sin might be, how deep the hole we have dug, wherever we find ourselves. He is our merciful Savior and we need to trust in his mercy and love.

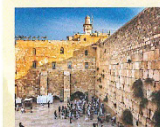
