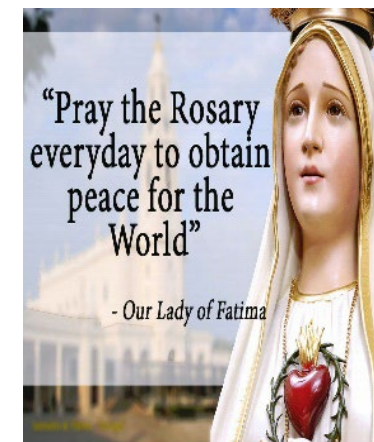

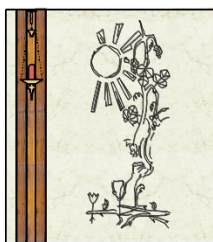

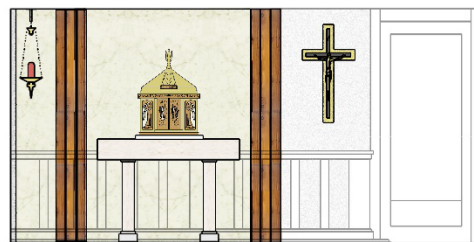

Jan. 19, 2025 – 2nd Sunday In Ordinary Time

Così facendo, Egli provvederà a noi in modi che supereranno le nostre aspettative.



The miracle at the Wedding at Cana was the first sign of Jesus' divinity and His profound love for us. Although it was not yet time for Jesus to begin His public ministry,

He graciously chose to reveal His power through this miracle. In doing so, He taught us how to use our gifts for the good of God's people and the church, echoing the message St. Paul shares in the second reading.

This miracle also highlights the important role of the Blessed Virgin Mary in our lives and the strength of her gift of prayer and intercession. Mary did not tell Jesus what to do; instead, she simply presented the need, trusting fully in His response. Similarly, when we pray, we should not impose a specific solution or outcome, but rather surrender our trust to Jesus. In doing so, He will provide for us in ways that surpass our expectations.
