



I primi collaboratori di Gesù, i discepoli, si sono lasciati attrarre dallo splendore di questa luce e hanno seguito Gesù nel suo peregrinare per città e villaggi predicando la notizia del Regno e nel suo rendersi prossimo alle sofferenze dei fratelli.

Gesù ha voluto che conversione e comunione andassero assieme, mostrando che entrare nel Regno non è questione solo di intelletto o di volontà, ma dedicarsi umilmente la propria vita e quella degli altri a rivelare Cristo, quale luce del mondo e di ogni anima. Solo allora si è nel regno di Dio: regno di pace e di gioia che nessuno può dare.

Many times we find ourselves in moments where we long for a light. But what we hear in today's readings is that the light is already among us; that hope is here. Isaiah tells us: "...on those who dwelt in darkness and the shadow of death, a light has dawned...." And St. Matthew takes these text of Isaiah and tells to his community, and to us that in the person of Jesus the light has come into the dark world. Jesus is the light: "I am the light of the world".

Normally light is something we welcome. However, sometimes we might fear it, because it shows up everything, things we want to see and things we would prefer to keep hidden from others and even from ourselves.

We need to believe and trust that the light of Christ comes as a friend. His light brings healing and not hurt, freedom not oppression, life not death. Those who follow Jesus will always have the light of life. By living in it, we become sources of light to others a lamp to their paths.




Come & See - Discernment Weekend Retreat


