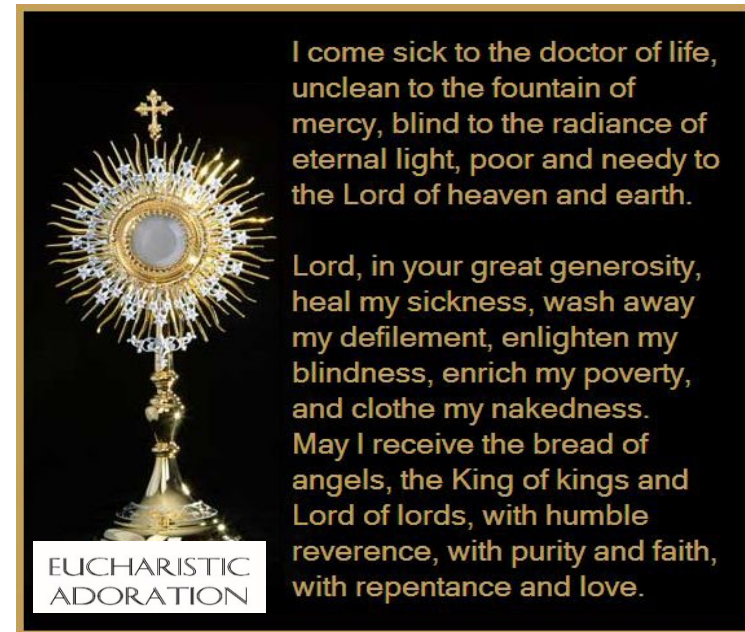
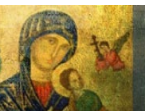

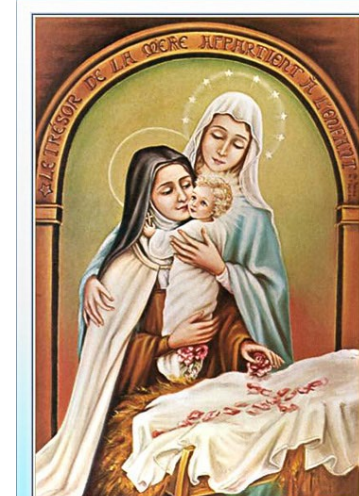

**January 8, 2023 – Epiphany of Our Lord**

Epiphany is the extension of the celebration of the birth of our Lord. The journey of the Magi, coming from the East, has always been the image of the path of every man who sincerely seeks God. They call us to the wisdom of the heart, and not be content with the superficial. They give gold, incense and myrrh. Gold can indicate all the good that they have accomplished in life: the motions of goodness, mercy and charity. Incense indicates the nostalgia of the infinite that dwells in their hearts. And myrrh indicates humility and human suffering but that find meaning only in God. We are also in the caravan of the Magi. Taking the step of the journey we are invited to reflect our relationship with God; let us be enveloped in the mystery of God in our suffering. The more we discover who we are, the more we are able to share what we have with others and especially with those who are in need.

**January 9, 2022 – The Baptism of Our Lord**

Nella festa del Battesimo del Signore, che chiude il ciclo liturgico del Natale, vengono evidenziate la divinità di Gesù e la sua missione messianica. È l'intera Trinità che si manifesta: il Padre che invia il Figlio, il Figlio che si dona nella sua missione per la nostra salvezza, lo Spirito Santo che ci introduce in questo mistero.



On the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which closes the liturgical cycle of Christmas, the divinity of Jesus and his messianic mission are highlighted. It is the whole Trinity that manifests itself: the Father who sends the Son, the Son who gives himself in his mission for our salvation, the Holy Spirit who introduces us into this mystery.

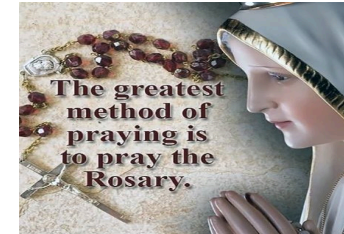

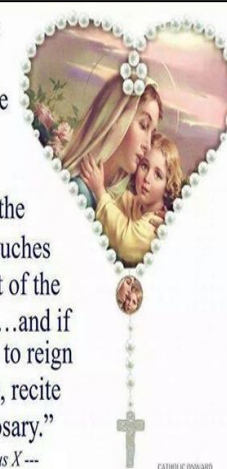
