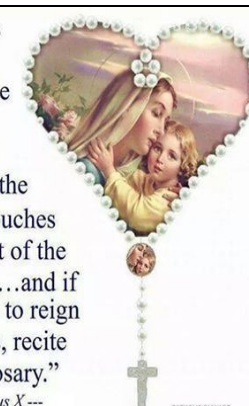
If one of your loved ones would like to receive this Sacrament of Anointing, please call the office.

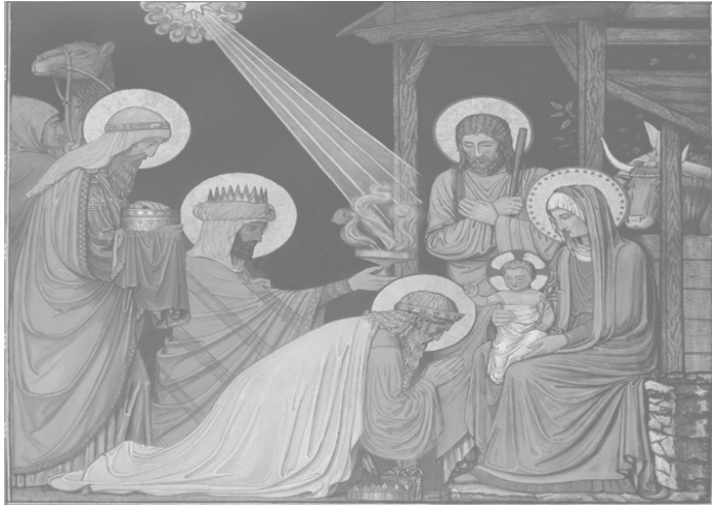

Epiphany is the extension of the celebration of the birth of our Lord. The journey of the Magi, coming from the East, has always been the image of the path of every man who sincerely seeks God. They call us to the wisdom of the heart, and not be content with the superficial. They give gold, incense and myrrh. Gold can indicate all the good that they have accomplished in life: the motions of goodness, mercy and charity. Incense indicates the nostalgia of the infinite that dwells in their hearts.
