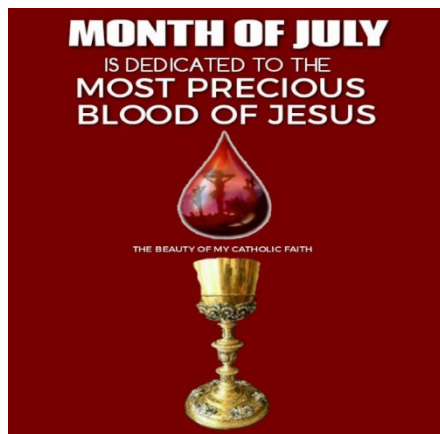

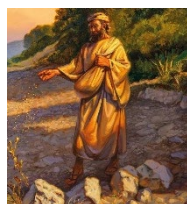

RCIA is a journey of conversion on the living community of faith. It is an ongoing process in which adults and children prepare for initiation through prayer, rituals, reflection on the Word of God, teachings of the Church, community activities and support from and service to others.

RCIA culminates in the Sacraments of Initiation

RCIA is for:

Adults who have not received any of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation)

Adults who have been baptized Catholic but have not been Confirmed and/or not received their First Communion.

Children who attend public or are being Home schooled, who are 8 years old (in grade 3) or older and who have not been baptized or received First Communion.
