Too often we heard that our work is our prayer when we are busy to pray. When we are tempted to justify ourselves for not having time to pray by saying, "My work is my prayer", let us remember this: It is alright to pray while we work; but it is not possible to work while we pray. As we always say, first things first. Jesus reminded Martha about this. Before working, we have to pray first so that there is guidance, enlightenment, inspiration and strength from God. If we know we will be very busy on that particular day, the more time we need to spend in prayer. So, if we are made to choose: work or prayer? The answer is: work and prayer. Work alone is useless; prayer alone is meaningless. If the question is, which of the two should be first? The answer is prayer first, and then work. When man works, it is only man that works; when man prays, it is God who works. So when prayer precedes our work, we are confident that God will help us finish our work successfully and fruitfully. There will no more worries, stress and anxieties.
