**RCIA** culminates in the Sacraments of Initiation

**RCIA** is for:

- Adults** who have not received any of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation)
- Adults** who have been baptized Catholic but have not been Confirmed and/or not received their First Communion.
- Children** who attend public or Catholic school or are being Home schooled, who are 8 years old (in grade3) or older and who have not been baptized or received First Communion.






