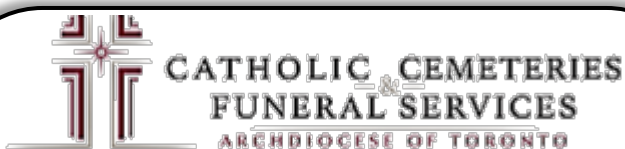

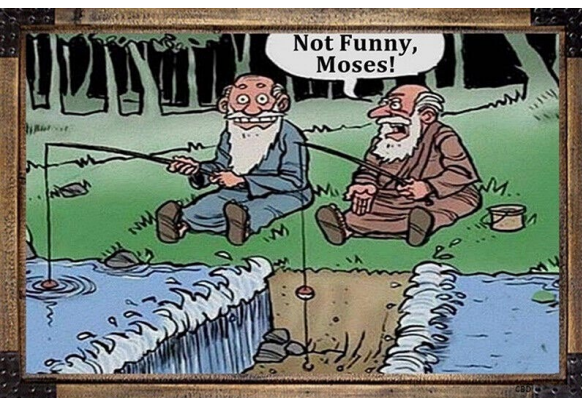

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's readings, we are reminded that God's
relationship with His people is rooted in love and purpose.
Reminder to see ourselves as both recipients and bearers
of God's mercy. We are gathered by His love, transformed
by His grace, and sent to be signs of His kingdom in a world
that still hungers for hope.

In the first reading, God tells Israel that they are His
"treasured possession," chosen not for privilege alone, but
for service — to be "a kingdom of priests, a holy nation." It
is a call to live differently, to reflect God's holiness in the
world.

In the second reading, deepens this truth by showing that
God's love is not conditional. Christ died for us "while we
were still sinners." This is the heart of the Gospel — God's
initiative comes before our worthiness.

In the Gospel, Jesus looks at the crowds and is moved with
compassion because they are "like sheep without a
shepherd." His response is not only to care for them
Himself but to send His disciples to share in His mission: to
heal, to proclaim, to bring God's kingdom near. The harvest
is abundant, but the labourers are few — and we are called
to be among those labourers.

compassione che scaturisce l'invito di Gesù: «Pregate il
signore della messe perché mandi operai nella sua
messe!» (Vangelo). Quanto bisogno ha l'umanità
smarrita di pastori, di operai del Regno, di gente donata
che si prenda cura di essa! Dio per primo lo ha fatto con
noi e, nel suo disegno d'amore, desidera farlo anche
attraverso di noi.

Se il Libro dell'Esodo (I Lettura) ci ricorda come ci ha
sollevato su ali di aquila per stringere con noi la sua
alleanza, la Lettera ai Romani (II Lettura) manifesta che il
suo amore gratuito ha raggiunto il culmine quando il
Figlio ci ha amato fino a morire, «mentre eravamo
ancora peccatori». Chi, scoprendosi amato così, non
sente l'urgenza di riamare a sua volta? È la dinamica del
regno di Dio: «Gratuitamente avete ricevuto,
gratuitamente date». Se siamo amati, amiamo come
apostoli (= inviati), "regno di sacerdoti" mandati a
predicare, guarire, risuscitare... ad essere sacramento
della vita di Dio per ciascuno dei suoi figli.
