

Set their souls on fire with love for your people.


Grant them the wisdom, understanding, and strength they need to follow in the footsteps of Jesus.

June 16, 2024 11TH Sunday in Ordinary Time - Yr B

Gesù nel Vangelo ci presenta un terreno fecondo quale luogo della rivelazione del Regno. Un piccolo seme può essere segno della pienezza del dono di Dio, in cui la potenza di salvezza è strettamente connessa alla sua umiltà. È nella piccolezza, infatti, che si sviluppa «la salvatrice potestà» del Signore che fa fiorire il giusto (Salmo responsoriale). Colui che è l' "Immenso" nella sua natura divina si è fatto minuscolo nella natura di servo, corroborando la fede del battezzato che, pur vivendo nell'esilio, sa di «abitare presso il Signore» (II Lettura). Senza l'umiltà, il cristiano è sterile, la sua fede inoperosa; dalla sua superbia nascono discordie. Ma Dio umilia «l'albero alto» e innalza «l'albero basso» (I Lettura) e, nel suo Regno, produce insperati frutti. Egli, infatti, sempre risponde alle aspirazioni dell'uomo, ma infinitamente le supera. Il regno di Dio è Gesù stesso, il quale incrocia il cammino dei cercatori della verità: «Chiunque trova lui, ha la vita eterna» (Canto al Vangelo). Gesù è il Cristo, l'unico Salvatore, la sola speranza di quanti provano il dolore per la Iontananza da Dio. La sua parola viva ed eterna risana i cuori, suscita gioia e pace.

In the Gospel, Jesus presents us with fertile ground as a place of revelation of the Kingdom. A small seed can be a sign of the fullness of God's gift, in which the power of salvation is closely connected to his humility. It is in smallness, in fact, that "the saving power" of the Lord develops and makes the just flourish. He who is the "Immense" in his divine nature has become tiny in the nature of a servant, corroborating the faith of the baptized who, despite living in exile, knows that he "dwells with the Lord". Without humility, the Christian is sterile, his faith is inoperative; discord arises from his pride. But God humiliates "the tall tree" and raises "the low tree" and, in his Kingdom, produces unexpected fruits. In fact, he always responds to man's aspirations, but infinitely surpasses them. The kingdom of God is Jesus himself, who crosses the path of seekers of truth: "Whoever finds him has eternal life". Jesus is the Christ, the only Savior, the only hope of those who feel the pain of distance from God. His living and eternal word heals hearts, arouses joy and peace. - La Domenica
