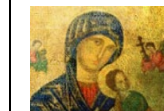

11TH Sunday in Ordinary Time – Yr A

Forse un po' troppo abituati a ricevere questa informazione, ai nostri orecchi suona scontato che Dio non è muto, ma parla; non comanda, ma promette; non chiede, ma vuole donarsi; non impone, ma invita. Eppure sono le caratteristiche fondamentali del suo agire, mai ovvie, e che richiedono all'uomo di porsi in ascolto, di rispondere al suo appello, coinvolgendo la propria libertà e responsabilità. Così è stato per Mosè, chiamato ad annunciare la prosperità per il suo popolo nella sequela di Dio (I Lettura), così per i dodici primi discepoli, invitati da Gesù ad annunciare il Regno con la stessa umiltà e potenza del Signore (Vangelo). L'invito di Dio è gratuito, è l'espressione della sua volontà di comunione con l'uomo per renderlo collaboratore nell'opera di salvezza; chiede a chi lo accoglie la medesima gratuità per la quale ogni offerta non è una imposizione, ma dono libero e liberante. Solo così è possibile giungere all'estrema offerta di sé, a immagine di quella di Cristo che, quando eravamo ancora peccatori, ha donato la sua vita per noi (II Lettura).

The gospel today is showing us the compassion of Jesus towards us. It is a signal of the nearness of God and of God's reign. The work must continue and a structure is needed if that is to happen. Twelve male disciples are named as the core group invited to carry forward the work of Jesus, although other references in this gospel suggest that discipleship is by no means limited to the twelve. They are given authority to preach and to heal. For the present, their mission is restricted to "the lost sheep of the house of Israel." Jesus reaches out beyond his own people. His disciples, women and men, will do so only after they have walked the whole journey to Jerusalem in his company. The "harvest" is no less demanding in our times and our mandate is no less compelling than that of our first century counterparts. We seek out the ways that are possible for us,

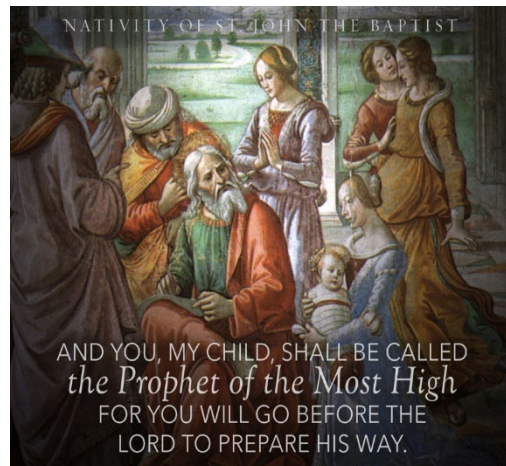
