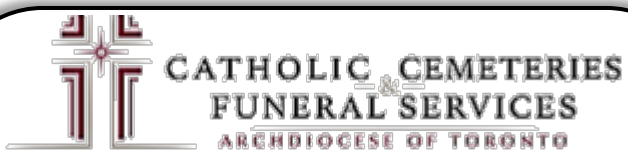

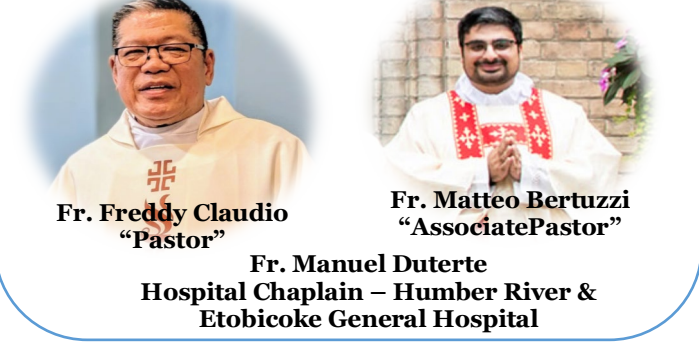

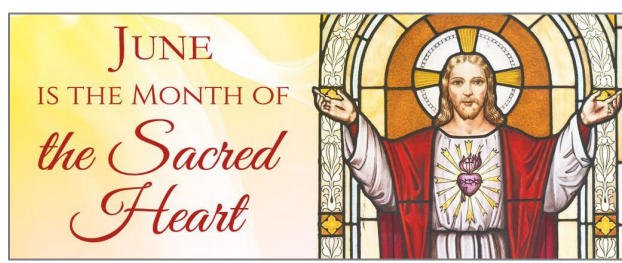

12th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Nel Vangelo di oggi, Gesù vuole farci capire che per Dio non esiste una vita umana anonima e senza volto. Ogni persona vive nella famiglia di Dio e nella Sua casa. Dio conosce nei minimi dettagli ogni aspetto della nostra vita. E si preoccupa profondamente di ciò che accade a ciascuno di noi.
Anche se a volte possiamo sentirci piccoli, insignificanti e senza alcuna importanza, non è così che Dio Padre ci vede. Non siamo passerai. Siamo Suoi figli e figlie, che Dio ama così tanto da aver permesso a Suo Figlio di morire per noi. Ecco perché abbiamo i crocifissi nelle nostre chiese. Perché il crocifisso ci rivela quanto Dio si prende cura di ognuno di noi e ci mostra anche la vastità, l'ampiezza, l'altezza e la profondità con cui si è prodigato per dimostrarci il Suo amore. È in quel crocifisso che tu ed io possiamo riconoscere il nostro vero valore e l'importanza che abbiamo agli occhi di Dio.

In today's gospel, Jesus wants us to understand that with God there is no such thing as a nameless, faceless individual human life. Every person lives in God's family and in His house. God knows in detail each and every aspect of our lives. And He cares profoundly about what happens to each of us. Even though at times we may feel small, worthless and of no significance whatsoever, that is not how God our Father feels about us. We are not sparrows. We are His sons and daughters, ones that God loves so much that He allowed His Son to die for us. Which is why we have crucifixes in our churches. For the crucifix tells us how much God cares for each and every one of us, and likewise shows us the length, the breadth, the height and depth He has gone to demonstrate His love for us. It is in that crucifix that you and I can recognize our true worth and the value that we have in the eyes of God.
