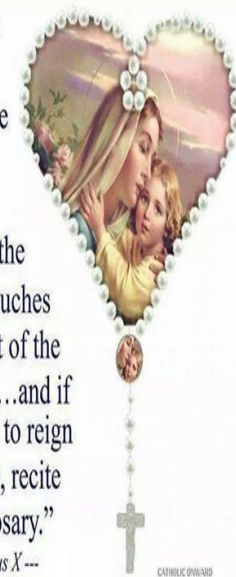

Grant that as St. John was martyred for truth and justice, so we may energetically profess our Faith in You, and lead others to the Way, the Truth, and Eternal Life.

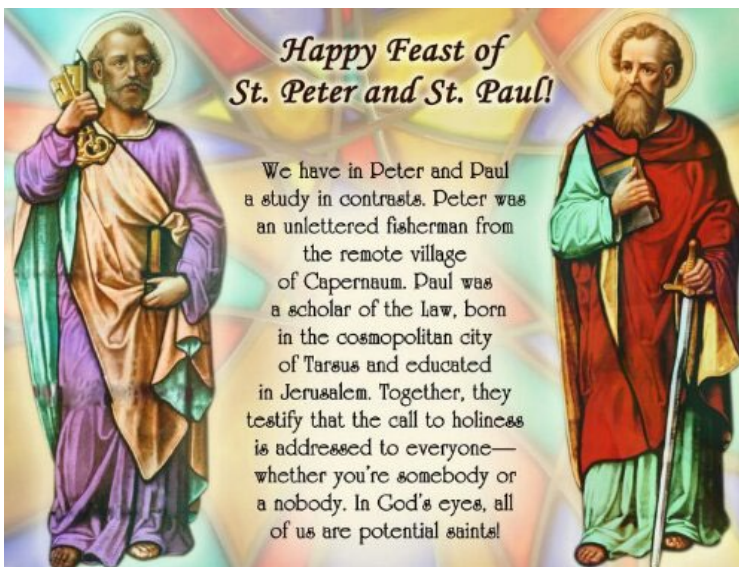

RCIA culminates in the Sacraments of Initiation

RCIA is for:

Adults who have not received any of the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion, Confirmation) Adults who have been baptized Catholic but have not been Confirmed and/or not received their First Communion.

Children who attend public or Catholic school or are being Home schooled, who are 8 years old (in grade 3) or older and who have not been baptized or received First Communion.
