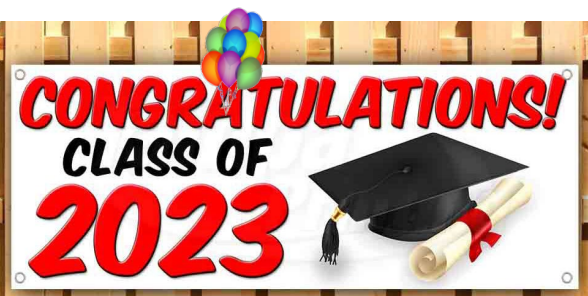
If one of your loved ones would like to receive this Sacrament of Anointing, please call the office.

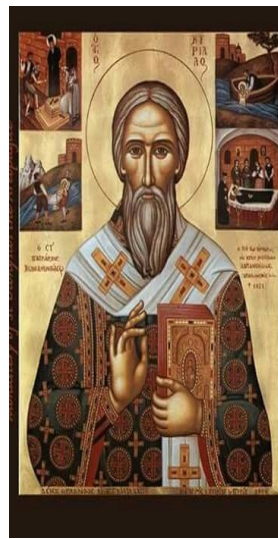

12TH Sunday in Ordinary Time – Yr A

L'esistenza umana è da sempre minacciata e ciò suscita quel sentimento così indebolente da far bloccare ogni entusiasmo: la paura! Con essa aumentano l'instabilità e l'incertezza dell'esistenza, mettendo in questione il senso stesso della vita. Anche i personaggi della Bibbia sono spesso presi dalla paura, ma sempre la voce di Dio li chiama a rinsaldare il proprio spirito confidando nella forza della sua grazia. Gesù addirittura invita i suoi discepoli a non aver paura nemmeno di quelli che possono uccidere il corpo, ma che non hanno potere sull'anima, e rassicura quanti confidano in lui che la Provvidenza di Dio è sempre all'opera nella loro vita. Sicuri della forza di Dio, è possibile annunciare la buona notizia del Vangelo nonostante l'incomprensione del mondo. È la missione della Chiesa: annunciare "dai tetti", senza temere ostilità e persecuzioni, la salvezza di Dio. Dalle piccole "risurrezioni" quotidiane, dagli affanni della vita alla risurrezione eterna per la comunione definitiva con Dio.

In today's gospel, Jesus wants us to understand that with God there is no such thing as a nameless, faceless individual human life. Every person lives in God's family and in His house. God knows in detail each and every aspect of our lives. And He cares profoundly about what happens to each of us. Even though at times we may feel small, worthless and of no significance whatsoever, that is not how God our Father feels about us. We are not sparrows. We are His sons and daughters, ones that God loves so much that He allowed His Son to die for us. Which is why we have crucifixes in our churches. For the crucifix tells us how much God cares for each and every one of us, and likewise shows us the length, the breadth, the height and depth He has gone to demonstrate His love for us. It is in that crucifix that you and I can recognize our true worth and the value that we have in the eyes of God.

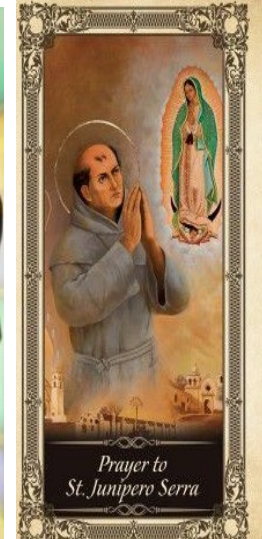


Your accumulated offenses surpass not the multitude of God's mercies: your wounds surpass not the great Physician's skill.
