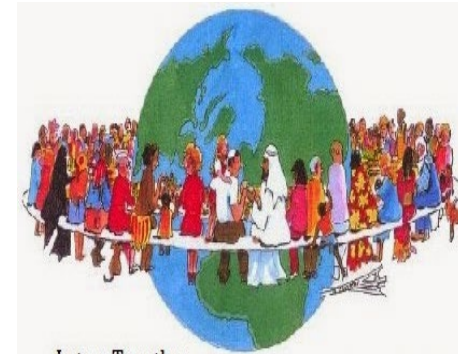

## June 28, 2026 13<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

La presenza di Gesù, vero Dio e vero uomo, modifica del tutto le relazioni umane, da considerare sotto una luce nuova. Egli rivendica una precedenza assoluta su tutti e su tutto, anche sugli affetti naturali più cari, compresi quelli familiari. Ad essi Gesù antepone anche le relazioni più consone alla sua missione, come quella del profeta che lo annuncia, del giusto che accoglie, del discepolo che lo segue. Non viene risparmiata neppure la propria vita terrena, che non va tenuta per sé, perché la si può ritrovare solo in Gesù, nella sua risurrezione. Un episodio dell'Antico Testamento ci riferisce il comportamento di un'illustre donna di Sunem, la quale aveva dato un dignitoso alloggio ad Eliseo, perché ritenuto «un uomo di Dio, un santo», che la ricompensa con l'annuncio che diverrà presto madre (*I Lettura*). San Paolo ci introduce nei misteri della vita di Cristo, della sua morte e risurrezione. Poiché attraverso il battesimo «siamo stati sepolti insieme a lui nella morte», viviamo ora con lui, risuscitato dai morti, e possiamo camminare in una vita nuova.

Hospitality means encountering the presence of God in others, usually in those whom we least expect. The virtue of hospitality is the virtue of recognizing the presence of God in others and nourishing this presence. We as a community are to look for the opportunities to be hospitable--and, of course, there are plenty of occasions for hospitality. Maybe it is simply a kind word to a stranger - or even a smile. When we live in such a busy and hectic world, we tend to brush off people who need help. A kind smile or a "hello" to someone waiting with us in a grocery line may be the only kindness that person encounters all day. We become fully alive as Christians through the generous giving of ourselves. What is more important than sending checks for charitable causes is giving of ourselves to people: in the way we speak to them and about them, in the way we forgive their failings, in the way we encourage them, console them and help them, and even in the way we think about them. These types of generosity reflect warmth radiating from the very love of God.

Remember those who have died in our prayers esp: **Dolorato Liberta**. Eternal rest grant unto them O LORD, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen

**Children** who attend public or are being Home schooled, who are 8 years old (in grade 3) or older and who have not been baptized or received First Communion.
