

June 23, 2024 13TH Sunday in Ordinary Time – Yr B

L'evangelista Marco ci ha narrato la risurrezione della figlia di Giairo, capo della sinagoga, e la guarigione della donna con perdite di sangue. Today's gospel passage beautifully illustrates the transformative power of faith in the healing process. We witness two healings performed by Jesus. First, a woman who had been suffering from blood loss for 12 years, touches the garment of Jesus and is healed. The second healing is the resuscitation of the daughter of Jairus, the synagogue official of Capernaum, a testament to the power of faith in the face of death.

It's important to remember that these two women represent each one of us, who, like them, are called to build life. In the Eucharist, we are given the opportunity to touch Him, to connect with His divine presence. In the lives of all the people around us, we have the opportunity to touch the image of God. To be saved, all we need to do is to reach out and touch Him in the sacraments, in the Word of God, and in the lives of people around us. This accessibility of salvation is our hope.
