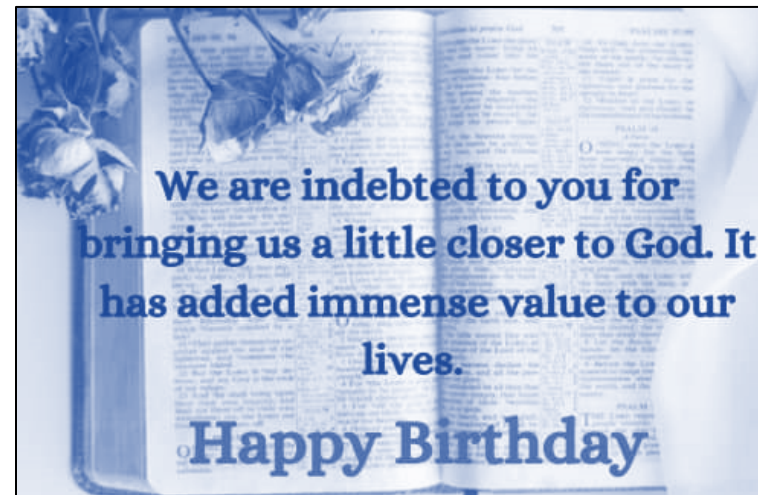

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus

La manna era un cibo che il popolo d'Israele non
conosce- va, e che gli stessi padri non avevano
mai conosciuto. E noi conosciamo il dono
dell'Eucaristia? Magari lo conosciamo troppo? Ci
siamo abituati? Allora l'odierna festa è
un'occasione splendida per riconoscere il santo
mistero, l'immenso mistero che celebriamo.
Gesù desiderò restarci vicino attraverso il pane e
il vino consacrati dalle parole dei suoi sacerdoti.
Fu esaudito! Il Padre gli ha concesso questo
donarsi smisurato in cui si spoglia, e si consegna
a noi, correndo il rischio di essere calpestato da
sacrilegi e, peggio ancora, dall'indifferenza. Pur
calpestato, non ha mai rinunciato, non rinuncia a
donarsi: può darsi amore più grande? Davvero,
era ed è immensa la sete di Gesù di donarci la
Vita vera fin da quaggiù, e di farci diventare in lui
un solo corpo. L'Eucaristia ci fa vivi, perché ci fa
"uno". È il pane dei pellegrini, per camminare
verso l'Amore autentico, cioè verso il Cielo. Beati
gli invitati alla mensa dell'Agnello!

The church teaches us that: "The Eucharist is the
source and the summit of the Christian life...For in the
blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual
good of the Church, namely Christ himself...The
Eucharist is also the culmination both of God's action,
sanctifying the world in Christ and, of the worship
men offer to Christ... In brief, the Eucharist is the sum
and summary of our faith..." (CCC1324-5).

Therefore, today's celebration is a celebration of life,
salvation and grace. It teaches us that as real food,
the Eucharist is the true body and blood of Christ
which nourishes our soul. It is a concrete way through
which Christ is divinely present with us every day and
moment.

This means that we should adore and offer Christ the
reverence due to him. Any moment spent in the
presence of the Most Holy Sacrament is both a
golden moment and a moment of grace. Let us adore
Christ saying: "Oh Sacrament Most Holy; Oh,
Sacrament Divine, all praises and all thanksgiving be
yours in every moment and time."
