June 8, 2025 – Pentecost Sunday

Today is the birthday of the Church. It is a commemoration and celebration of the receiving of the Holy Spirit by the early Church. We celebrate this day to recognize the gift of the Holy Spirit, realizing that God's very life, breath and energy live in believers. The celebration reminds us of the reality that we all have the unifying Spirit that was poured out upon the first disciples and upon each of us through baptism. Even though Jesus ascended to heaven, He is with us all the time: "I will not leave orphans; I will go and I will return back to you and remain with you until the end of the world". So this feast of Pentecost reminds us that the Holy Spirit is present with us in all condition of life through his gifts of: wisdom, knowledge, understanding, intellect, fortitude, fear of God and piety.

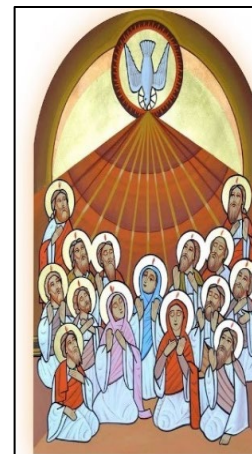
