

L'uomo, sedotto dal diavolo, si ritrova smarrito e turbato. Si nasconde; a Dio che lo cerca risponde: «Ho avuto paura» (I Lettura). Nel Vangelo gli avversari di Gesù lo accusano di complicità col demonio, gettando discredito sul suo operato. La realtà è che proprio Gesù riporta il definitivo trionfo contro il regno di Satana, e ne decreta la fine: ogni tentazione è vinta da colui che ha vinto ogni tentazione! Gesù accusa di bestemmiare contro lo Spirito Santo coloro che attribuiscono deliberatamente la sua opera al demonio. Il rischio che corrono è di rifiutare con ostinazione di intraprendere un cammino di conversione con un indurimento del cuore che può sfociare nell'impenitenza finale. Gesù con la sua redenzione si pone in netta antitesi con chi dall'inizio è omicida e nemico dell'uomo. Cristo è il «più forte» (cf. Mc 1,7), perché mandato dal Padre con autorità. Chi accoglie il messaggio del Vangelo supera ogni sbandamento e diviene così per Gesù «fratello, sorella e madre», con la promessa di vivere per sempre accanto a lui nella gloria (II Lettura).

Today's gospel narrates Jesus' encounter with his people and family. They thought he was out of his mind. They accused him of being possessed when he was actually liberating the possessed. Every true disciple of Christ is, His brother, sister, mother and a member of his victorious family. He came to save all who are ready to do the will of God. Of course, Mary his Mother is a great model of this for all of us. Hence, Christ did not disrespect his own faithful mother. Rather, he teaches an important lesson today. That, through faith and obedience to God's will, we all have the opportunity to become members of his victorious and happy

Also, Christ reminds us that it is not status, but action in response to God's call that determines who belongs to his victorious family. To become part of the victorious family of Christ is a dynamic process. It flows from a personal encounter with Christ. It also flows from faithfulness and obedience to God's will. Hence, if we are disciples of Christ, we must prove it through our faith and obedience to God's will. - Fr. Njoku Canice Chukwuemeka, C.S.Sp.
