

March 15, 2026 – 4th Sunday of Lent

Il racconto evangelico del «cieco nato» è stato sempre interpretato in prospettiva battesimale. Il battesimo è la nostra piscina di Siloe, il passaggio dalle tenebre alla luce. Fin dai tempi apostolici il battezzato era chiamato «illuminato», appellativo che esprimeva la sua nuova condizione. Gesù è la luce. Aderire a Cristo-Luce è acquisire la capacità di vedere la realtà di Dio, il mistero dell'uomo e della storia con occhi nuovi; è acquisire una mentalità di fede, assumendo come criterio di valutazione e di scelta la logica del vangelo.

Il battezzato è entrato nella zona luminosa di Cristo-Luce che lo porta «a vedere la storia come Lui, a giudicare la vita come Lui, a scegliere e ad amare come Lui, a sperare come insegna Lui, a vivere in Lui la comunione con il Padre e lo Spirito Santo».

The man's journey from blindness to sight in the gospel today, symbolises the journey from unbelief to faith, which is from darkness to light. Physical sight is a wonderful gift which we should never take for granted, but faith is a deeper and more wonderful kind of seeing.

Paul says to the Ephesians, 'Once you were in darkness, but now you are light in the Lord.' Those who have been enlightened by Christ can never again see themselves and their lives in the same light as before. Everything is lit up with an inner radiance. Faith helps us find our way through the chaos, confusion and darkness of the modern world.

Laetare Sunday



The Fourth Sunday of Lent is called **Laetare Sunday**, from the first words of the Introit at Mass, "Laetare Jerusalem" ('Rejoice, O Jerusalem').

Like Gaudete Sunday midway through Advent, Laetare reminds us of the event we look forward to at the end of the penitential season and the joy in anticipation of the Resurrection. The vestments for this day will be rose, as they are on Gaudete Sunday in Advent.


