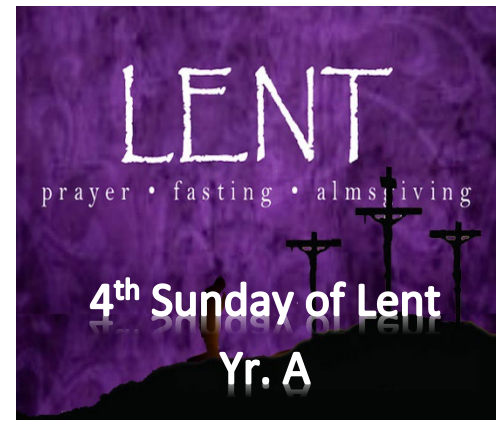

How to Pray The Holy Rosary

1. On the crucifix, make the sign of the cross and then pray the Apostles' Creed.
2. On the first large bead, pray the Our Father.
3. Pray the Hail Mary on the following three small beads.
4. On the chain before the next bead, pray the Glory Be.
5. On the large bead, meditate on the first mystery and pray the Our Father.
6. Pray a Hail Mary on each of the 10 smaller beads.
7. On the chain before the next decade, pray the Glory Be & The Fatima Prayer.
8. Repeat each decade (steps 5, 6 & 7) starting with the Our Father until you reach the medal in the center.
9. Finish by praying the Hail, Holy Queen and closing prayer.

The Rosary is a Scripture-based prayer. It begins with the Apostles' Creed, which summarizes the great mysteries of the Catholic faith. The Our Father, which introduces each mystery, is from the Gospels. The first part of the Hail Mary is the angel's words announcing Christ's birth and Elizabeth's greeting to Mary. The Mysteries of the Rosary center on the events of Christ's life.

6. Recitare il Gloria al Padre.
7. Dopo ogni decina recitare la preghiera di Fatima, richiesta dalla Beata Vergine Maria.
8. Enunciare il Secondo Mistero, poi recitare il Padre Nostro. Ripetere n. 5, n. 6 e n. 7 e proseguire con il Terzo, Quarto e Quinto Mistero nello stesso modo.
9. Recitare la Salve Regina alla conclusione delle cinque decine.
