

March 2, 2025, 2025 – 8th Sunday In Ordinary

In today's gospel, Jesus teaches us that the quality of our heart determines the quality of our words and actions. He says, "A good person, out of the store of goodness in his heart produces good, while an evil person, out of a store of evil produces evil; for from the fullness of the heart the mouth speaks.

The church reminds us that while physical appearance could be deceptive, what determines who we are is what comes from within us. This includes the quality of our words, the wisdom, and the goodness that we manifest.

God sees the heart and always will. We may put on a great show of words and actions, but it is what is at the root of these that is so visible to God. Focusing on the faults of others, no matter how true, only attempts to take the focus off our own.

As Paul reminds us, the heart that produces the goodness revealed in speech is the heart that is rooted in the risen Lord Jesus.

Possiamo mettere in scena un grande spettacolo di parole e azioni, ma è ciò che è alla radice di queste cose che è così visibile a Dio. Concentrarsi sui difetti degli altri, non importa quanto veri, tenta solo di distogliere l'attenzione dai nostri.

Come ci ricorda Paolo, il cuore che produce la bontà rivelata nel discorso è il cuore che è radicato nel Signore Gesù risorto.

THIS DAY IS THE BEGINNING OF LENT

On these days, penance is to be considered an important requirement of the Christian life. Fulfillment of this duty involves prayer, works of piety and charity, and self-denial by fulfilling one's obligations more faithfully and especially by observing the prescribed fast and abstinence.

Christian fasting obtains its full meaning when we deprive ourselves of food in order to be more open for prayer, to share more in the suffering, of those who are starving and to save money to give to the poor. Fasting among Christians is a penitential discipline intended to open our hearts to God and others, a means of purification and spiritual liberation, a witness of the depth of our faith.

The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. Parents are reminded of their duty to introduce children gradually to the understanding and practice of penance. Adult example will be the greatest influence in this matter.




