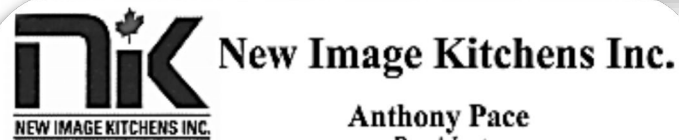

March 26, 2023 – 5TH Sunday of Lent

Le tre letture di oggi ci parlano di risurrezione, di vita. La promessa annunciata dal profeta: «Ecco, io apro i vostri sepolcri, vi faccio uscire dalle vostre tombe» (I Lettura), è la promessa del Signore che ha la vita e ha la forza di dare vita a chi è 'morto'. San Paolo, poi, ci dice che siamo sotto il dominio dello Spirito Santo, fonte di vita (II Lettura). Il Vangelo presenta il culmine dell'itinerario quaresimale di fede, in cui Cristo è presentato in tutta la sua forza di salvezza, anticipando nel segno di Lazzaro la vittoria sulla morte. Ciò non riguarda solo una speranza futura. La liberazione dalla morte è realtà che ci riguarda ora. Siamo invitati ad "obbedire" al grido di Gesù: «Lazzaro, vieni fuori», perché tutti siamo segnati dalla morte. Cristo non si rassegna ai sepolcri che ci siamo costruiti con le nostre scelte di male e di morte. Lui ci chiama ad uscire dal buio in cui ci siamo rinchiusi, accontentandoci di una vita mediocre, e ci invita alla vera libertà. La risurrezione comincia da qui: decidendo di obbedire al comando di Gesù uscendo alla luce, alla vita.



There are a few lessons we must learn from today's gospel.

**First**, this miracle is an expression of love. We were told that when the message came to Jesus: "The man you love is ill." Jesus went because of the love he had for Lazarus and his family. Just as their joy was his joy, also, their sorrow became his sorrow. So, "Jesus wept!"

**Second**, our faith is very important in the working of miracle for us. Christ asked Mary and Martha: "I am the resurrection and the life...Do you believe in this...?" So, in order to resurrect Lazarus, the love of Christ and the faith of his sisters brought down the power of the Holy Spirit. Hence, the third lesson is that with Christ, and through power of the Holy Spirit everything is Possible. This is because, Jesus has authority over life and death.

**Finally**, Jesus is ever willing to help us no matter what it will cost him. It does not matter how long we have been spiritually dead or exiled. He knows us, loves, and calls us by our names as he called Lazarus: "I Come out!" If we hear and obey his voice, then he will restore life to our weak and mortal bodies through the power of the Holy Spirit.
