

March 29, 2025 – PALM SUNDAY

Today's readings present us the triumphant entrance of Jesus to Jerusalem. It portray his pain and suffering. Inspite the rejection pain and humiliation, Jesus stands firm and, faithful to God till the end. In the process, there is a transformation. The leader becomes a servant; shame turns to honor; mockery becomes praise; fear turns to trust; abandonment becomes love; despair turns into hope; and above all death blossoms into new life. Easter Triduum



GIOVEDÌ SANTO/HOLY THURSDAY
April 2 @ 7 pm

Il mistero del Giovedì Santo è
"l'amore degli amori".

È l'amore che genera santità; l'amore che perdona i peccatori; l'amore che dona Dio stesso all'anima dell'uomo; l'amore che lega in uno l'essere umano e Cristo stesso.

Holy Thursday is the most complex and profound of all religious observances, saving only the Easter Vigil.

It celebrates both the institution by Christ himself of the Eucharist and of the institution of the sacerdotal priesthood (as distinct from the 'priesthood of all believers') for in this, His last supper with the disciples, a celebration of Passover, He is the self-offered Passover Victim, and every ordained priest to this day presents this same sacrifice, by Christ's authority and command, in exactly the same way.

The Last Supper was also Christ's farewell to His assembled disciples, some of whom would betray, desert or deny Him before the sun rose again.

VENERATION OF THE CROSS

In the seventh century, the Church in Rome adopted the practice of Adoration of the Cross from the Church in Jerusalem, where a fragment of wood believed to be the Lord's cross had been venerated every year on Good Friday since the fourth century. According to tradition, a part of the Holy Cross was discovered by the mother of the emperor Constantine, St. Helen, on a pilgrimage to Jerusalem in 326. A fifth century account describes this service in Jerusalem. A coffer of gold-plated silver containing the wood of the cross was brought forward. The bishop placed the relic on the table in the chapel of the Crucifixion and the faithful approached it, touching brow and eyes and lips to the wood as the priest said (as every priest has done ever since): 'Behold, the Wood of the Cross.'

Adoration or veneration of an image or representation of Christ's cross does not mean that we actually adore the material image, of course, but rather what it represents. In kneeling before the crucifix and kissing it we are paying the highest honor to our Lord's cross as the instrument of our salvation.

The Great Vigil of Easter

This is the night when Christ broke the bonds of death and hell, and rose victorious from the grave.

The Great Vigil of Easter is the most joyous and beautiful liturgy of the Church Year. This most ancient of Holy Days is rich in symbolism, saturated with the Word of God, and is, in fact, the principal celebration of the Resurrection of Our Lord. Throughout the ages, it has been in this service that countless saints have proclaimed, "Alleluia, Christ is risen!" Indeed, when the Easter Vigil is not celebrated, there is a significant loss in the Christian's subsequent Easter worship. If we are to "die with Christ" in Baptism, then it is unthinkable that we should not experience the total darkness of the tomb, in order that the splendid light of the Resurrection might be all the more glorious.
