March 3, 2024 –Third Sunday of Lent

Quando Gesù entro’ nel tempio, lo trovo’ come un mercato. La gente vendeva e comprava; e quindi Gesù’ fu adirato. L'atto di culto, cioè i sentimenti interiori di gratitudine,e di lode si erano trasformati in religiosità esterna. Bisogna sapere che la religiosità esterna non è la fede. La esternita’ soffoca lo spirito, cioe’ la relazione autentica con il Signore. Gli atti di culto hanno senso solo nella misura in cui sono espressioni non di religiosità ma di fede. Dobbiamo interrogarci Perché andiamo in chiesa? Perché siamo 'praticanti'? Per essere in regola? Per dare a Dio qualcosa in modo che lui ci dia altro in cambio? Oppure, lo facciamo perché riconosciamo in Dio un padre che ci ama, perché siamo consapevoli di essere nelle sue mani e che tutto quello che abbiamo e più ancora tutto quello che siamo è un suo dono? Come ci comportiamo in chiesa. La lampada accesa vicino al tabernacolo indica la presenza del Signore realmente e veramente. Appena entriamo in chiesa quale e’ la nostra devozione? Ci tratteniamo con il Signore oppure siamo distratti chiaccherando, salutandoci senza la consapevolezza della presenza del Signore?

In today’s gospel, John narrates Jesus’ encounter with those profaning God’s Sanctuary. His action simply demonstrates that He is God’s wisdom and the fullness of the law. His zeal distinguished him from the authorities. Instead of representing God’s interest, they expressed their selfish economic and social interests. It also distinguishes him from temple pilgrims who simply visited the temple without real devotion to God. What do we learn from today’s gospel? First, we are not supposed to keep quiet or remain indifferent while things go wrong. This is especially in the house of God, our homes, offices, or any place at all. Also, we must not allow our personal intention to destroy the sanity of our Church, family, state, or country. The Church is the house of God and a place of worship. We must keep it holy and respect it. Also, it reminds us that our body and the body of Christ is the Temple of God. So, we must not defile it.
