



March 8, 2026 – 3rd Sunday of Lent

L'acqua, la luce, la vita sono i doni battesimali che, in queste tre ultime domeniche di Quaresima, rivelano la premura di Dio per noi, sue creature. L'acqua è il dono che Dio fa al suo popolo assetato nel deserto (I Lettura). L'acqua che la donna di Samaria attinge al pozzo di Giacobbe rivela in lei una sete più profonda da placare, un vuoto interiore da colmare e un desiderio cocente di pienezza che rendono inquieta la sua esistenza. Quest'acqua attinta ogni giorno le avrebbe procurato nuova sete: «Chiunque beve di quest'acqua avrà di nuovo sete». Non così l'acqua viva attinta al "pozzo spirituale" che è Gesù: «Chi berrà dell'acqua che io gli darò, non avrà più sete in eterno» (Vangelo). È, questa, la promessa messianica fatta anche a tutti noi e realizzata nel dono dell'acqua viva del nostro battesimo, l'acqua che «ha riversato nei nostri cuori l'amore di Dio per mezzo dello Spirito» (II Lettura). Come la donna di Samaria, oggi sarai anche tu grato per questo dono? Saprai chiedere con lei: «Signore, dammi quest'acqua, perché io non abbia più sete»?

Today's story of the woman of Samaria is a metaphor for our own lives – often lived in deserts of alienation, sinfulness, and despair. During the season of Lent in particular, we long for the refreshing waters of repentance, forgiveness, and wholeness. To repent is to acknowledge our own need for life in the midst of the desert, our need for breaking down the barriers that exist among us, our need for finding the living water that will truly quench our thirst. The question that Jesus puts to the Samaritan woman: "Give me a drink", expresses the passion of God for every man and woman, and wishes to awaken in our hearts the desire for the gift of "a spring of water within, welling up for eternal life": this is the gift of the Holy Spirit, who transforms Christians into "true worshipers," capable of praying to the Father "in spirit and truth". Only this water can extinguish our thirst for goodness, truth and beauty! Only this water, given to us by the Son, can irrigate the deserts of our restless and unsatisfied soul, until it "finds rest in God," as per the famous words of St. Augustine.


