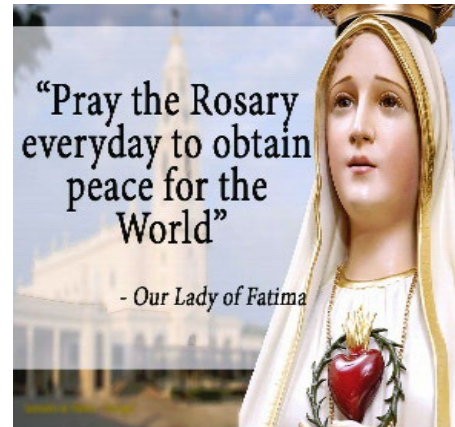

6th Sunday of Easter – May 10, 2026

Jesus assures us in today's Gospel that He will not leave us alone. He won't make us children of God in Baptism only to leave us "orphans," He asks the Father to give us His Spirit, to dwell with us and keep us united in the life He shares with the Father.

We see the promised gift of His Spirit being conferred in today's First Reading.

Peter and John, pray and lay hands on the newly baptized—that they might receive the Holy Spirit. This is the origin of our sacrament of Confirmation by which the grace of Baptism is completed and believers are sealed with the Spirit promised by the Lord.

We remain in this grace so long as we love Christ and keep His commandments. And strengthened in the Spirit whom Jesus said would be our Advocate, we are called to bear witness to our salvation—to the tremendous deeds that God has done for us in the name of His Son.

La liturgia rende viva questa promessa di Gesù per noi: in essa celebriamo sempre il Mistero Pasquale di Cristo morto e risorto, vivo in mezzo a noi. La presenza di Gesù nella nostra vita è resa possibile dall'azione dello Spirito Santo. Lo Spirito Santo è l'avvocato di Gesù nel grande processo intentato contro di Lui dall'diavolo: ricordiamo che il vangelo di Giovanni presenta tutta la passione di Cristo come una lotta tra Gesù e il principe di questo mondo. In questa lotta, l'avvocato di Gesù, e quindi anche dei suoi discepoli, è lo Spirito Santo. Ma Egli è anche il "consolatore", cioè colui che sta con chi è solo: è la realizzazione piena della promessa di Gesù: io sono con voi fino alla fine del mondo. Lo Spirito prosegue nel cuore dei credenti la presenza di Gesù Cristo, che puo' essere conosciuto solo da chi ha lo sguardo della fede e sa vedere nella propria vita i segni della presenza di Dio.

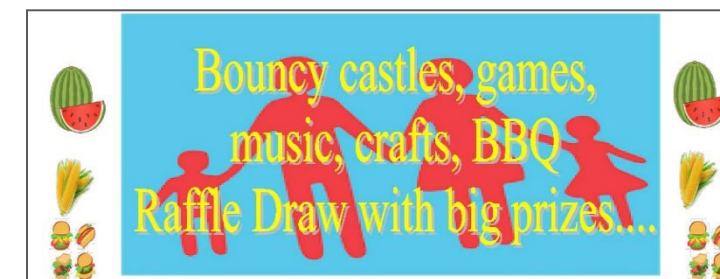
SOFFERENTI
