


Today’s Gospel passage gives us Jesus’ new commandment: “*Love one another as I have loved you*” (John 13:35). This new commandment demands a radical change of vision and a reordering of our priorities in life; to embrace new attitudes, new values and new standards of relating to God, to other people and, indeed, to our whole environment. We fulfill the demand of this commandment when we love ourselves the way the Lord wants us to; when we acknowledge that we are children of God and that the Triune God resides in our souls, making our bodies the temple of the Holy Spirit. We cannot learn to cherish others and care for them if we have never learned to do the same for ourselves

We love others by responding to their everyday needs with love and compassion. We love others by comforting and protecting those who have experienced loss. We love others by serving others in every possible way no matter how small, seeing the face of Jesus in them. We love others by forgiving rather than condemning, by challenging rather than condoning. Finally, we love others by sacrificially sharing our time, talents and blessings with them.

Amiamo gli altri servendo gli altri in ogni modo possibile, non importa quanto piccolo, vedendo il volto di Gesù in loro. Noi amiamo gli altri perdonando piuttosto che condannando, sfidando piuttosto che condonando. Infine, amiamo gli altri sacrificando con loro il nostro tempo, i nostri talenti e le nostre benedizioni.


