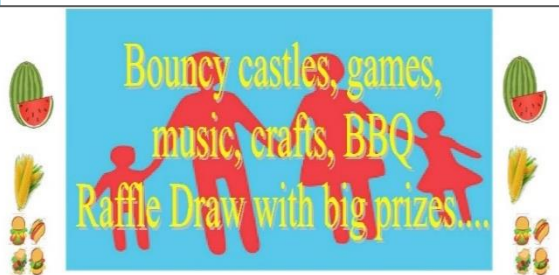

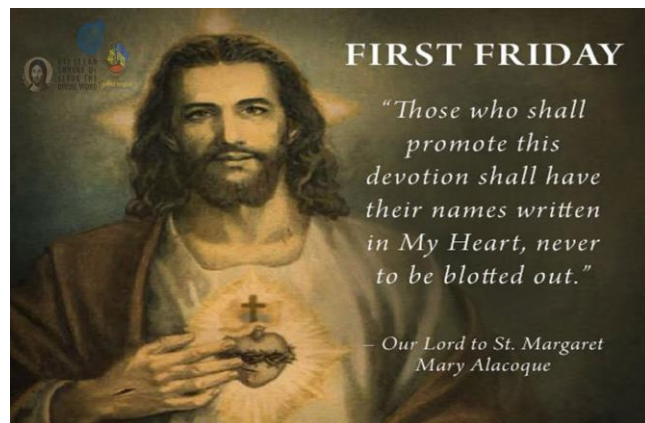

**May 31, 2026 – MOST HOLY TRINITY**

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity which is a mystery difficult to comprehend. In our daily life we begin every one of our prayers, activities, programs or works with the sign of the cross and call upon God, "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." The Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity consists of this: the Father is God, the Son is God, and the Holy Spirit is God, and yet there are not three Gods, but only one God with three attributes. We have Father who is the creator, Son the redeemer and Holy Spirit the sanctifier and the counselor. This is the Mystery of the Trinity of Persons in the one God. The Holy Trinity is not the product of human reasoning, but the face with which God has revealed Himself, walking with humanity. The family, the domestic Church, is a reflection of Trinitarian love—the love of husband and wife, distinct and very different persons, generates the child who is from them but is nonetheless distinct from them, indeed absolutely unique.

Il Mistero della Santissima Trinità consiste in questo: il Padre è Dio, il Figlio è Dio e lo Spirito Santo è Dio, eppure non ci sono tre Dei, ma un solo Dio con tre attributi. Abbiamo il Padre che è il creatore, il Figlio il redentore e lo Spirito Santo il santificatore e il consigliere. Questo è il Mistero della Trinità delle Persone nell'unico Dio. La Santissima Trinità non è il prodotto del ragionamento umano, ma il volto con cui Dio si è rivelato, camminando con l'umanità. La famiglia, la Chiesa domestica, è un riflesso dell'amore trinitario: l'amore tra marito e moglie, persone distinte e molto diverse, genera il figlio che è da loro ma è comunque distinto da loro, anzi assolutamente unico.
