"Before the coming of Christ, the Church must go through a final trial that will shake the faith of many believers. The persecution that accompanies his pilgrimage on earth will reveal the "mystery of iniquity" in the form of a religious imposture that offers men an apparent solution to their problems, at the price of apostasy from the truth ". These words of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (n. 675) are impressive. They are actually the echo of today's Gospel: Jesus clearly announces to us that the Church, his Body, will participate in his Passion. For our part, Jesus tells us, only one thing counts: perseverance. Persevere in faith. Always choose mercy and benevolence. "Do not prepare our defense", but receive "the word and wisdom" of love from Jesus. And prayer: praying for souls, praying to be freed from "pride and injustice", so that the "Sun of justice, at its rising, may bring us benevolent rays" and not burning fire (I Reading). As St. Paul said, let us beware of agitation or idleness. Pray for knowing how to love. To dwell in love.

Quante volte leggiamo le parole di Gesù sul giudizio e sulle persecuzioni come se non ci riguardassero! Eppure, la persecuzione dei cristiani è oggi sempre più violenta e spesso ci raggiunge direttamente, quando veniamo condannati perché rifiutiamo un pensiero che fa a meno di Dio. Come sono preziose, allora, le parole di Gesù, che ci dice che queste prove devono accadere: sono i dolori del parto della storia in cammino verso il suo orizzonte certo, che è la beatitudine eterna. E mai ci verrà meno il sostegno del Signore che promette: «Io vi darò parola e sapienza» (Vangelo). L'orizzonte è quello della beatitudine eterna, ma questo non significa disimpegno dalla realtà del mondo, come quei cristiani di Tessalonica che vivevano «senza fare nulla e sempre in agitazione» (II Lettura). Al contrario, quest'orizzonte dà valore e senso al nostro impegno: lavorando perché scompaiano superbia e ingiustizia, permettiamo all'amore e alla verità del Vangelo di permeare la storia. La certezza che il «sole di giustizia» sorgerà con raggi benefici (I Lettura) ci dona forza per vivere appieno questa nostra responsabilità di cristiani, di testimoni autentici del Vangelo.

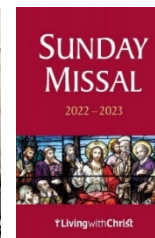
