32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C

The main theme of today's readings is the reality of life after death and of the relationship between our lives on earth and the life of glory or punishment that will follow. They invite us to consider the true meaning of the Resurrection in our lives. The same theme of the resurrection of the dead is the basis of the confrontation described in today's Gospel passage. Jesus speaks of God as the God of the living and declares that heavenly life with God in glory is totally different from earthly life, and that there is no marriage in heaven in the earthly sense. **The message is that we need to live as people of the Resurrection** We are not to lie buried in the tomb of our sins; we are to live joyful and peaceful lives, constantly experiencing the real Presence of the Risen Lord. **We need to offer living worship to a living God.** If our God is the *God of the living*, our worship of this living God also has to be alive in us. That means our participation in prayers and songs during the Holy Mass should be active and our behavior in Church reverent, as we offer our lives and all our activities to our living God on the altar with repentant and grateful hearts.

Il tema principale delle letture di oggi è la realtà della vita dopo la morte e del rapporto tra le nostre vite sulla terra e la vita di gloria o punizione che seguiranno. Ci invitano a considerare il vero significato della risurrezione nella nostra vita. La prima lettura descrive una famiglia ebrea, una madre con i suoi sette figli, rifiutano di andare contro la legge di Dio e subiscono la sofferenza e il martirio con la speranza che un giorno risorgeranno dai morti e ricompensati da Dio. Lo stesso tema della risurrezione dei morti è la base dello scontro di Gesù' con i Saducei. E Gesù parla di Dio come il Dio dei vivi e dichiara che la vita celeste con Dio nella gloria è totalmente diversa dalla vita terrena e che non esiste un matrimonio in cielo in senso terreno. Il messaggio è che dobbiamo vivere come persone della Risurrezione. Non dobbiamo rimanere seppolti dai nostri peccati; bensì vivere una vita gioiosa e pacifica, nella costante presenza del Signore risorto. Se il nostro Dio è il Dio dei vivi, anche la nostra adorazione di questo Dio vivente deve essere viva in noi. Ciò significa che la nostra partecipazione alle preghiere e ai canti durante la Santa Messa dovrebbe essere attiva e il nostro comportamento nella Chiesa riverente, offrendo la nostra vita e tutte le nostre attività al nostro Dio vivente sull'altare con pentimento e cuore riconoscente.

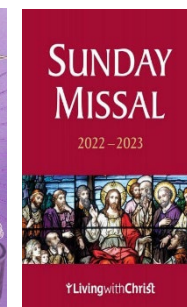
New Envelope 2023 will be available on the first weekend of Dec in the lobby. It will be in numerical number but alphabetical listing is available for reference.
