The lesson we can learn from today's gospel is to realize that gratitude, giving thanks, and being thank-full people, changes us not God. We don't give thanks in order to change God's mind. The beatitude of thankfulness changes us; it changes our hearts, our outlook on life, and our relationships with others. It's a truth that sets us free. Gratitude is the BE-attitude. It changes how we live. With it we find happiness.

Grateful hearts are the hallmark of authentic Christians. Those who possess the virtue of gratitude are truly rich. They not only know how richly they have been blessed, but they continuously remember that all good things come from God. People bound together by gratitude are always discovering and awakening abundant sources of strength. The more thankful a person is, the richer he or she is within. Thankful people store up in their grateful memory all the good experiences of the past.

That is why we go to mass to celebrate Eucharist – our prayer of thanksgiving – so we can go on our ways, walking in the glorious freedom of the sons and daughters of God.

St. Wilfrid Feast Day

October 12

St. Wilfrid^[a] (c. 633 – c. 709) was an English [bishop](#) and [saint](#).

Born a [Northumbrian](#) noble, he entered religious life as a teenager and studied at [Lindisfarne](#), at [Canterbury](#), in [Gaul](#), and at Rome; Born in Northumberland in 634. *St. Wilfrid* was an outstanding personage of his day, extremely capable and possessed of unbounded courage, remaining firm in his convictions despite running afoul of civil and ecclesiastical authorities. He helped bring the discipline of the English Church into line with that of Rome. He was also a dedicated [pastor](#) and a zealous and skilled missionary.

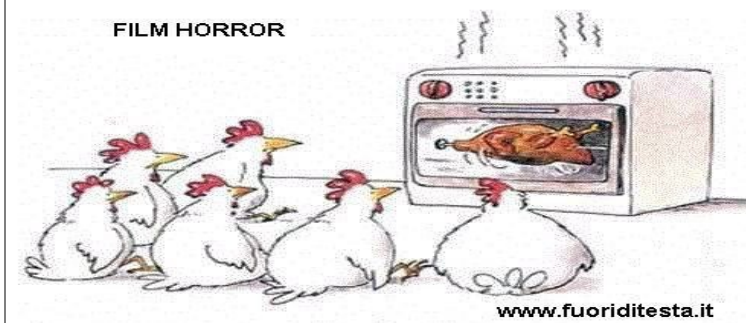

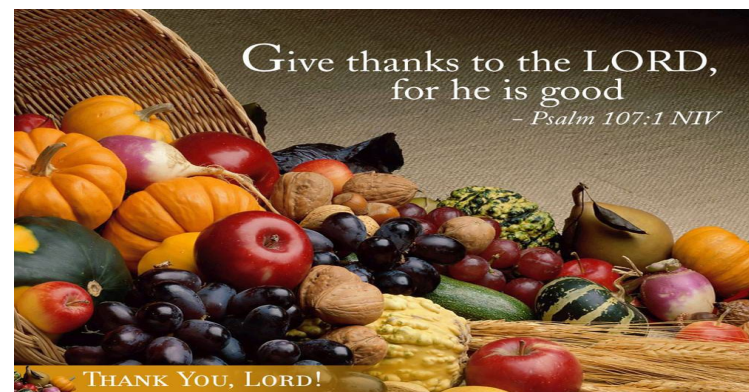
