There are times when we pray almost "by instinct". We then discover that prayer is "necessary" to us like the air we breathe. There is a prayer that arises from the human experience of impotence and is launched towards God with the strength of a "cry": it is the cry of faith, like that of the widow who, having no means of their own to obtain justice, addresses herself with insistence to the Only one who can get it.

The raised hands of Moses express the confident trust of those who, in weakness and fatigue, know they cannot count on their own strength and lean on the stone that is Christ.

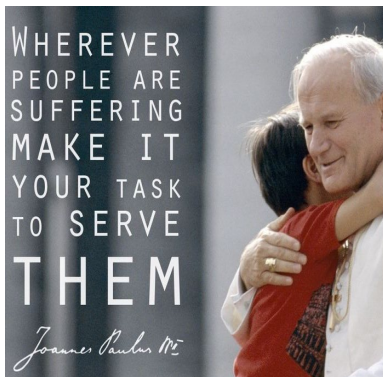
-They sing with the psalmist: "My help comes from the Lord." We are small and fragile in the midst of great trials in life, where the strength of belief alone sustains us. The faith to which Jesus invites us is a boundless trust in God, who listens to the cry of his elect for him, because he cares for them.

La fede a cui Gesù ci invita è una fiducia sconfinata in Dio, che ascolta il grido dei suoi eletti, perché di loro si prende cura.

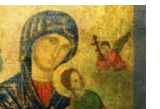
