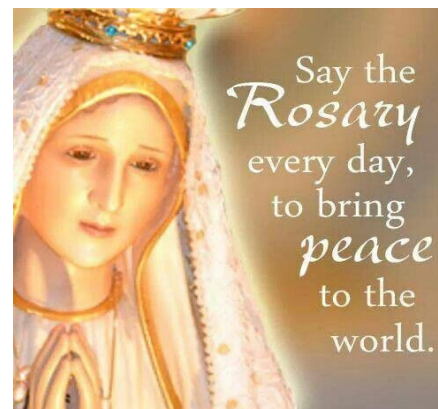

St. Wilfrid (c. 633 – c. 709) was an English **bishop** and **saint**. Born a **Northumbrian** noble, he entered religious life as a teenager and studied at **Lindisfarne**, at **Canterbury**, in **Gaul**, and at Rome; Born in Northumberland in 634,

St. Wilfrid was an outstanding personage of his day, extremely capable and possessed of unbounded courage, remaining firm in his convictions despite running afoul of civil and ecclesiastical authorities. He helped bring the discipline of the English Church into line with that of Rome. He was also a dedicated **pastor** and a zealous and skilled missionary.

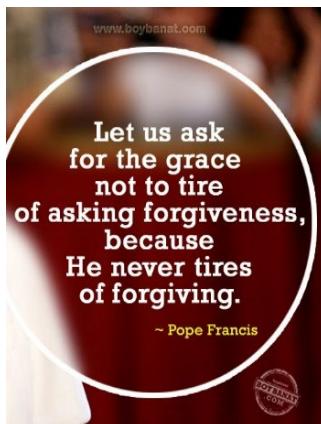
IN questa Domenica la Parola di Dio ci consegna una meravigliosa catechesi sulla famiglia e sull'amore: è un messaggio che bisogna comprendere profondamente per non travisarlo o comprometterlo con le situazioni in cui ci troviamo nella società contemporanea.

Di fronte ai farisei che fondano le loro argomentazioni affidandosi al precetto di Mosè, Gesù spiega che il significato dell'essere famiglia non si basa essenzialmente su un contratto, deve essere fatto risalire al progetto creativo di Dio (Vangelo). Adamo infatti riceve da Dio un aiuto corrispondente a lui: cioè una persona da amare e non qualcosa di cui semplicemente servirsi (I Lettura).

Così facendo egli dichiara che l'amore e l'unione familiare hanno origine in Dio e da Dio. Solo mantenendo il suo primato nella vita umana, è possibile realizzare la pienezza dell'amore e costruire la famiglia su basi che non potranno sgretolarsi. Diversamente la durezza del cuore umano troverà sempre qualche appiglio per disintegrare ciò che credeva aver costruito, come quella casa costruita sulla sabbia, che al primo vento contrario rischia di distruggersi.

The first pages of the Bible tell us that God created man and woman in his own image. That means that God, who is love, wanted to unite them in the bond of love and make them live for the love of each other. That is how it was in the beginning. That is how it should still be now. When Jesus came, he made the bond between husbands and wives even more sacred, assuring them of God's grace. Are people faithful to their yes given in the presence of God and the Church? Let us ask the Lord today for faithfulness and deep love between our married couples – and all our friendships.
