One of the most difficult things in life is correcting another person. What the Lord God wants from us is to find ways to draw others to HIM, by the way of gentle correction. That is a divine task. The passage we have today is all about how to deal with a neighbor who has wronged us. But we can also look at this from the other side where we are the one wronging someone else. It works both ways. The challenge is: how to bring about reconciliation with a deep awareness of the truth of the situation. All of us must learn that we offend others at times, that we misjudge others, that we take advantage of others, etc. If we can come to recognize our own brokenness and lack of love towards others, then we will find it much easier to deal with the brokenness and lack of love in others. Jesus acknowledges the reality of conflict and error and offers us a means for addressing such matters. It is on this teaching that the message of hope is found: Jesus is present with the community and will guide the community in its relation with each other and one can be assured of God's assistance.

Triumph of the Cross - September 14

This day is also called the Exaltation of the Cross, Elevation of the Cross, Holy Cross Day, Holy Rood Day, or Roodmas.

The liturgy of the Cross is a triumphant liturgy. We made the Sign of the Cross before prayer which helps to fix our minds and hearts to God. After prayer we make the Sign of the Cross to keep close to God. At Baptism we are sealed with the Sign of the Cross, signifying the fullness of redemption and that we belong to Christ. Let us look to the cross frequently, and realize that when we make the Sign of the Cross we give our entire self to God — mind, soul, heart, body, will, thoughts.

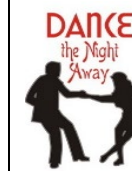

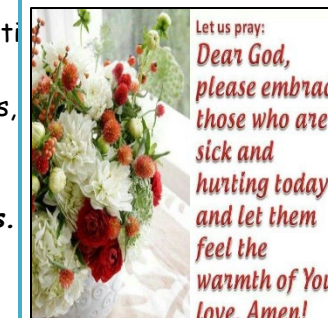
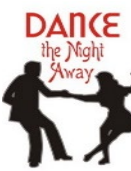
