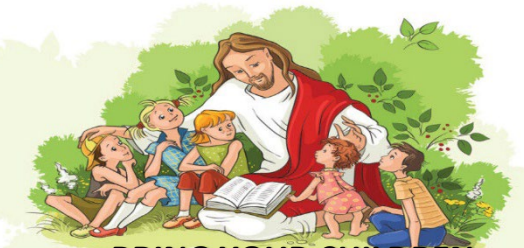

Se Dio, grande e magnanimo accoglie le nostre suppliche e perdona le nostre offese, anche noi dobbiamo usare pietà e misericordia verso i nostri fratelli, anche se sono colpevoli verso di noi. San Paolo offre un forte motivo di perdono delle offese: con il Risorto noi formiamo un solo corpo, per cui non viviamo più per noi stessi, ma per il Signore al quale apparteniamo). Come lui, anche noi dobbiamo saper vivere e morire per i fratelli. A Pietro che domanda al Signore se deve perdonare solo fino a sette volte, Gesù risponde: «Fino a settanta volte sette». Le caratteristiche del perdono cristiano sono quelle di perdonare tutti indistintamente, sempre e in ogni circostanza. Se perdoniamo solo a coloro a cui ci conviene, perché più forti di noi o a noi necessari, non siamo sulla scia del vero perdono. Il tale che aveva un debito di diecimila talenti siamo tutti noi, che usiamo male i doni che Dio ci elargisce. Se lui continua a credere in noi, anche noi dobbiamo dare credito all'altro. Non perdoniamo allora perché ci aspettiamo un ravvedimento, ma perché Dio fa così.

In today's Gospel, through the parable of the two debtors, Jesus teaches us that there should be no limit to our forgiveness and no conditions attached to our reconciliation. The forgiveness that we offer others is the indispensable condition which makes it possible for us to receive God's forgiveness and to pray meaningfully: "Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us." What God expects from us is limitless forgiving and an ability to overlook faults and to keep on loving even in the face of insults. We may never forget the hurt we have experienced, but we can choose to forgive and pray for our offenders. Time does heal memories. Forgiveness finally changes us from being prisoners of our past to being liberated and at peace with our memories. Forgiveness allows us to move beyond the pain, the resentment, and the anger. We need to forgive from the heart. To forgive from the heart is to forgive with the whole of one's being.

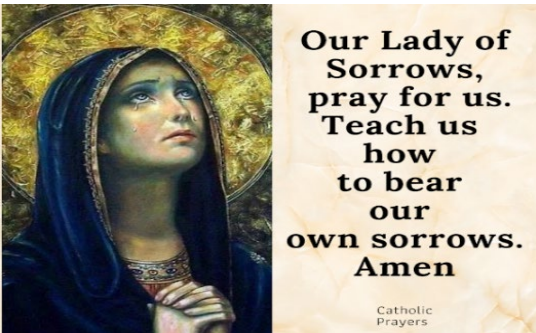
